Guide to Information Available Through The Model Publication Scheme 2015

The Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (the Act) requires Scottish public authorities to produce and maintain a publication scheme. Authorities are under a legal obligation to:

- publish the classes of information that they make routinely available
- tell the public how to access the information and what it might cost.

Edinburgh Bus Tours has adopted the **Model Publication Scheme 2015** produced by the Scottish Information Commissioner. The scheme has the Commissioner's approval until 31 May 2019.

The purpose of this Guide to Information is to:

- allow you to see what information is available (and what is not available) in relation to each class.
- state what charges may be applied.
- explain how you can find the information easily.
- provide contact details for enquiries and to get help with accessing the information.
- explain how to request information we hold that has not been published.

Availability and formats

The information we publish through the model scheme is, wherever possible, available on our website. We offer alternative arrangements for people who do not want to, or cannot, access the information online or by inspection at our premises. For example, we can usually arrange to send information to you in paper copy (although there may be a charge for this).

Exempt information

We will publish the information we hold that falls within the classes of information below. If a document contains information that is exempt under Scotland's freedom of information laws (for example sensitive personal information or a trade secret), we may remove or redact the information before publication but we will explain why.

Copyright

Where Edinburgh Bus Tours holds the copyright in its published information, the information may be copied or reproduced without formal permission, provided that:

- it is copied or reproduced accurately
- it is not used in a misleading context, and
- the source of the material is identified

Where Edinburgh Bus Tours does not hold the copyright in information we publish, we will make this clear.

Charges

This section explains when we may make a charge for our publications and how any charge will be calculated.

There is no charge to view information on our website or at our premises except where there is a statutory fee, for example, for access to registers.

We may charge for providing information to you e.g., photocopying and postage, but we will charge you no more than it actually costs us to do so. We will always tell you what the cost is before providing the information to you.

<p>Directors Report and Financial Statements</p> <p>Edinburgh Bus Tours is a subsidiary of Lothian Buses Plc.</p> <p>Lothian Buses Ltd is a publicly-owned business which operates profitably in the competitive and deregulated market for local bus services and, since the Company's shares are wholly owned by the various local authorities in the Lothians, there is a wider public interest in the Company operating successfully. Lothian Buses is the only publicly owned business in Scotland which operates in this competitive market. The Company's continued success and, as a consequence, its ability to generate income in the form of dividend payments to its shareholders and to sustain a high level of investment in both vehicles and other infrastructure is critically dependent on its competitive position not being undermined.</p> <p>Information regarding what Lothian Buses Ltd spends or plans to spend is therefore commercially sensitive information, and is considered exempt under the terms of -</p> <p><i>Section 33 Commercial interests and the economy</i></p> <p><i>sub-section (1) (b) - "Information is exempt information if – (b) its disclosure under this Act would, or would be likely to, prejudice substantially the commercial interests of any person (including, without prejudice to that generality, a Scottish public authority)."</i></p>	<p>Lothian Buses Annual Reports</p>
